Mandatory Student Fee Advisory Committee Friday, January 25, 2013

Crescent Room, Student Center Commons, 2:00 P.M. to 3:30 P.M.

- **1.** Attendance All Committee members were present. Twelve staff were present, as listed in the attendance list.
- 2. Review of Meeting Summary December 5, 2012 On a motion by Michael Kirka, seconded by Daniel Farmer, the Committee voted by consensus to approve the meeting summary from December 5, 2012 as posted on the web site.
- **3.** <u>FY2013 and FY2014 Budget Update</u> Jim Kirk shared the latest information with the Committee members on the status of the Georgia Tech budget for FY2013 and the FY2014.
- 4. Student Input on Fees Daniel Farmer updated the Committee on the efforts made to inform the student body at large about the fee increases proposed. The following steps were taken: (1) collected comments from an SGA Facebook post; (2) received comments through a feedback link posted via the SGA Twitter account; (3) collected comments through a feedback link posted via the Budget Office FAQ page and the SGA website; (4) received comments through a post on Reddit.com (GT); (5) advertising of the proposed fee increases through a video display in the Student Center; (6) informing all members of the SGA Senators and Representatives aware of the increases and methods of feedback. The Committee was presented with copies of a summary of the feedback collected from the Reddit.com (GT) website, since this site had received the most comments.
- 5. Presentation of Mandatory Fee Requests for FY2013 (For FY2014)

NOTE: The voting forms required by the Board of Regents are appended to these minutes. [The Committee's recommendations were forwarded to the Board of Regents staff on January 29, 2013.]

- Student Health Gregory Moore presented the Student Health proposal to increase the fee by \$6, from \$154 to \$160. Daniel Farmer made a motion, seconded by Carole Moore, to recommend to the President an increase in the fee by \$6, from \$154 to \$160. The Committee voted unanimously via roll call vote to approve the motion.
- Athletics Frank Hardymon presented the Athletics proposal to increase the fee by \$6, from \$127 to \$133. Gareth Guvanasen made a motion, seconded by Daniel Farmer, to recommend to the President that this fee be maintained at the current level. This motion was passed by a unanimous roll call vote.
- All Other Fees Arren Washington made a motion, seconded by Daniel Farmer, that a recommendation be made to the President that all other fees be maintained at their current levels. The Committee voted unanimously to maintain all current fee levels by roll call votes.

- **6.** <u>Special Institutional Fee</u> A discussion was led by Eran Mordel about how the students might express their sentiments regarding the Special Institutional Fee to the Board of Regents. Carole Moore suggested that advice from the President's Office be obtained as to how to proceed with this in the best interests of the Institute. Jim Kirk will follow up on this with Dene Sheheane.
- 7. <u>Next Meeting</u> Jim Kirk thanked the Committee for its work. Students will discuss whether they wish to reconvene the Committee later in the semester to discuss other mandatory fee issues.
