Meeting Summary

Mandatory Student Fee Advisory Committee Monday, December 08, 2014 Student Center Crescent Room, 3:00 P.M. to 5:00 P.M.

- 1. <u>Attendance</u> All committee members were present or represented. Additional staff members were present per the attendance list on the last page.
- 2. <u>Review of Meeting Summary November 5, 2014</u> The Committee reviewed the Meeting Summary from the November 5, 2014, and it was approved by unanimous consent.

3. Presentation of Mandatory Fee Requests for FY2016

- Health John Scuderi updated the committee on the status of the Health Services Fee. It was determined at this time that there would not be a request for an increase. The fee for health remains at \$160 for Fall and Spring semesters and a Summer fee of \$107.
- Athletics Marvin Lewis updated the committee on the status of Athletics Fee. It was determined at this time that there would not be a request for an increase. The fee for athletic remains at \$127 for Fall and Spring semesters and a Summer fee of \$40.
- <u>Transportation</u> Lance Lunsway and Sherry Davidson presented a proposal to increase the Transportation fee by \$3, from \$81 to \$84 for Fall and Spring semesters and \$54 to \$57 in Summer.
- Technology Fee Trevor Lindsay updated the committee on the status of Technology Fee and the need to consider a potential increase going forward. It was determined at this time there would not be a request for an increase. The fee for technology remains at \$107 for Fall and Spring semesters and a Summer fee of \$107.
- <u>Student Activity</u> There was not a request for a fee increase for the Student Activity Fee for FY2015.

4. Consideration of Motions on Fees for FY2016

Note: The voting forms required by the Board of Regents are appended to these minutes.

- <u>Health</u> Justin Eisenberg made a motion, seconded by Trevor Lindsay, to recommend to the President to allow the fee to remain at \$160. The Committee voted unanimously to approve the motion by a vote of 12 to 0.
- Athletics Laura Margaret Burbach made a motion, seconded by Trevor Lindsay, to recommend to the President to allow the fee to remain at \$127. The Committee voted to approve the motion by a vote of 7 to 4, with one abstention.

The remaining fee recommendations will be reviewed during January 16, 2015 meeting.

Mandatory Student Fee Participation Form

In January 2010, the Board of Regents amended Section 7.3.2.1 of the Policy Manual to expand student involvement in the review of mandatory student fees. According to the amended policy:

Proposals submitted by an institution to increase mandatory student fees and proposals to create new mandatory student fees shall first be presented for advice and counsel to a committee at each institution composed of at least fifty percent (50%) students, except in special circumstances when a general purpose fee is instituted system-wide by the Board of Regents. The committee shall include at least four students, who shall be appointed by the institution's student government association. Institutions and student government associations should make a concerted effort to include broad representation among the students appointed to the committee.

All mandatory student fees collected by an institution shall be budgeted and administered by the president using proper administrative procedures, which shall include the advice and counsel of an advisory committee composed at least fifty percent (50%) students, except in special circumstances when a general purpose fee is instituted system-wide by the Board of Regents. The committee shall include at least four students, who shall be appointed by the institution's student government association. Institutions and student government associations should make a concerted effort to include broad representation among the students appointed to the committee.

Mandatory student fees shall be used exclusively to support the institution's mission to enrich the educational, institutional, and cultural experience of students. All payments from funds supported by student mandatory fees shall be made according to approved business procedures and the appropriate business practices of the institution.

The policy, therefore, requires that:

- (1) The mandatory student fee request and budget for all mandatory student fees must be presented to an institutional committee.
- (2) 50% of the committee shall be students appointed by the student government association (minimum of four students).
- (3) The institutional committee shall serve in an advisory and counseling capacity.
- (4) Approval of the committee is NOT required for review of the fee request by the Board of Regents Central Office. However, no fee request will be reviewed without a completed and signed form.
